What is included

- All fishing rods, tackle and bait required for the session.
- Two session supervisors will be present.
- A first-aid officer will be onsite.
- Guidance with safe equipment use and participation.

All supplied fishing equipment remains the property of Community Care Tailored Support and must be returned at the end of the session.

Support arrangements

Open to adults aged 18+ from the general public, aged care and NDIS community. NDIS participants must attend with their own support worker or authorised support person. Their usual provider remains responsible for personal care, medication, behaviour support and individual assistance.

How to register

Email info@cctsupport.com.au to express your interest. Before attendance can be confirmed, email the completed participant information form and signed photography consent (select YES or NO). Places are limited; CCTS will confirm attendance in writing.

IMPORTANT

The session may be postponed or cancelled due to unsafe weather, site conditions or other safety concerns. Registered attendees will be contacted using the details provided.

Safety and preparation

Please review this page with the participant and their support worker

What to bring

- A support worker or authorised support person who understands the participant's needs.
- Drinking water, hat, sunscreen and weather-appropriate clothing.
- Enclosed, non-slip footwear suitable for a jetty environment.
- Any required medication, communication aid, mobility aid and personal support items.
- \$10 cash payment for the participant session fee.

Essential safety expectations

- Follow supervisor instructions and remain within the designated fishing area.
- Do not enter the water, climb railings or sit on the jetty edge.
- Check the casting area and wait for clearance before casting.
- Keep hooks covered or controlled when equipment is not in use.
- Ask a supervisor for help with hooks, tangled line or equipment concerns.
- Fishing must pause if wildlife, members of the public or changing conditions create a risk.
- Current South Australian fishing, species, gear and Adelaide Dolphin Sanctuary rules apply.

Individual suitability

CCTS may request further information or additional controls where a participant has mobility or balance concerns, seizures, impaired water awareness, behaviours that may create a risk near water, significant communication needs, allergies or another relevant health concern. A suitable lifejacket may be required following individual and site risk assessment.

Medical and emergency response

A first-aid officer and first-aid kit will be onsite. In an emergency, staff may contact emergency services and the participant's nominated emergency contact. Support workers must retain access to required medication and current emergency information.

Photography

Photographs may be taken during the session. Identifiable images will only be used by CCTS where the participant, or their authorised representative, has provided consent on the photography consent form in this pack. Declining photography consent will not prevent participation.

Dogs at the session

Pet dogs may not accompany attendees. Recognised assistance dogs, including guide dogs, may attend. Please advise CCTS when registering so safety arrangements can be planned.
